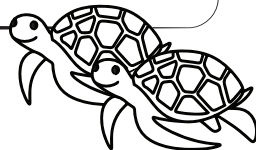




CAYMAN TURTLE CENTRE

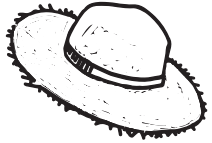

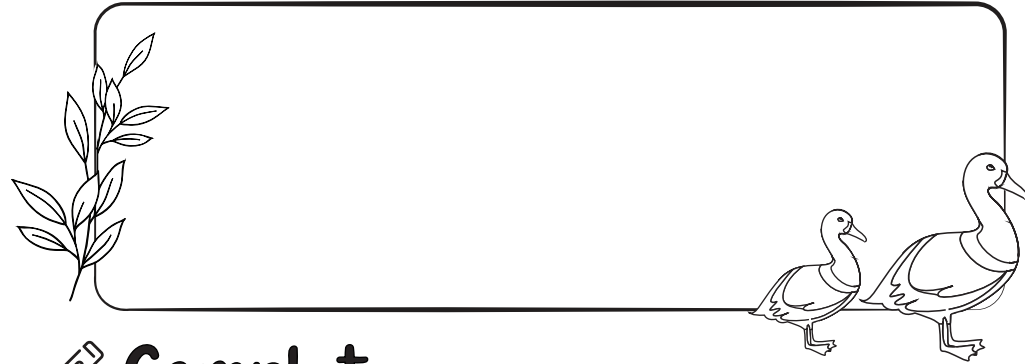

The National Trust for the Cayman Islands preserves natural environments and places of historic significance. This includes the Mission House which is one of the oldest house sites in Cayman.

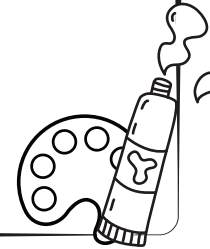

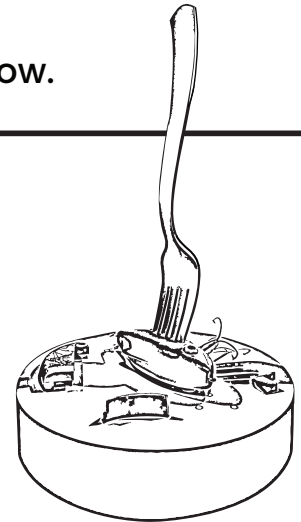

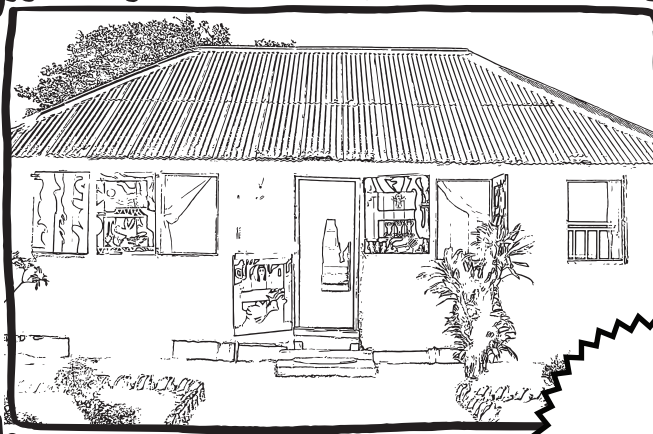

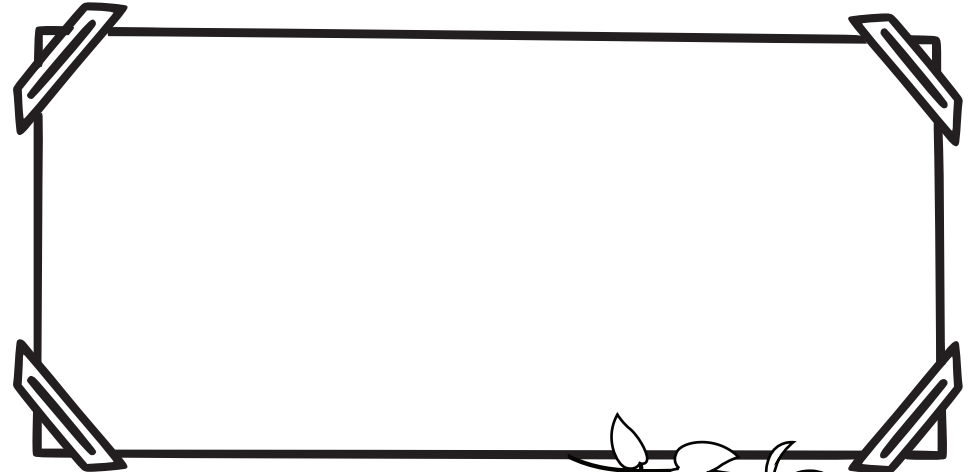

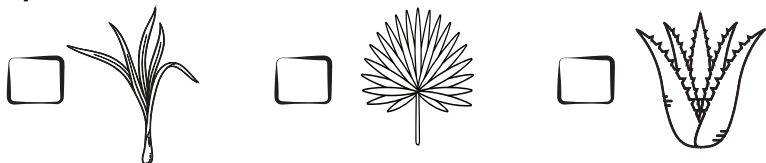


PEDRO ST. JAMES

The Harquail Theatre is our national stage where actors, dancers, and storytellers bring performances to life. It's a place for sharing culture, creativity, and community through the performing arts.

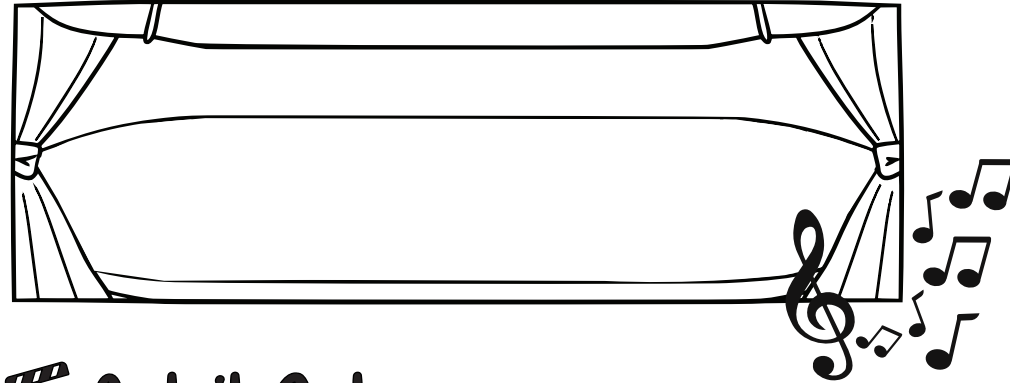
