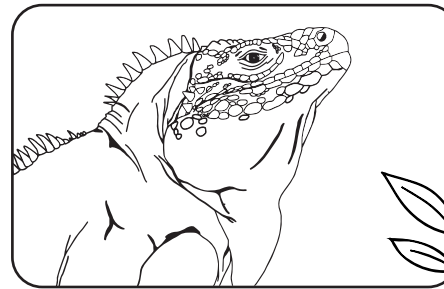

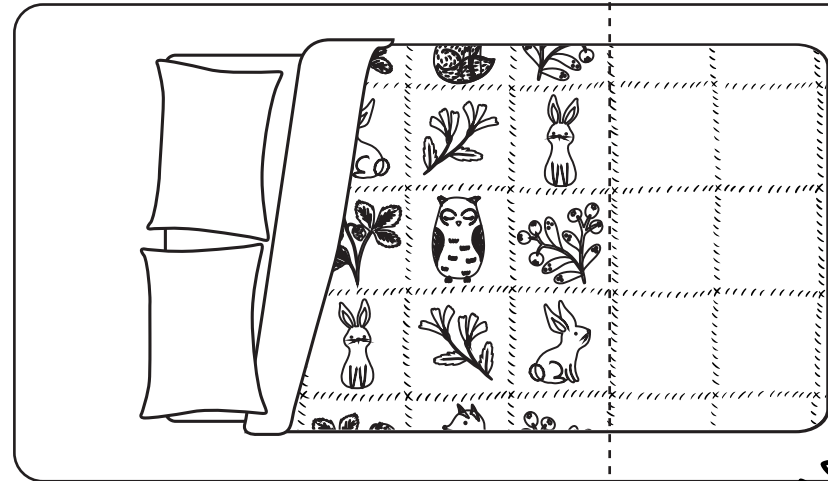

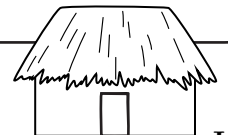

Culture Keepers User Guide

- Download and print each activity page. You may keep the pages in a folder or create a passport book.

To create the book:

- You will need:
 - *Glue or staples*
- Print double sided.
- Select flip on short edge.
- Fold pages along the middle line.
- Glue or staple pages together.
- Be sure to check organisation address and opening times before venturing out. This can be found at the bottom of each activity page.
- Remember to collect your stamp before you leave each site!

IMPORTANT

- The Culture keepers summer passport programme runs from **July 2nd through August 29th 2024.**
- All participating organizations retain the right to refuse entry in accordance with their own rules and regulations.
- Summer camp groups or other large groups of children are not eligible for entry using the Culture Keepers Passport on free days.

The Cayman Turtle Centre is one of several places in the world where you have the opportunity to see Green sea turtles at every stage of their life cycle, from egg to fully matured adult.

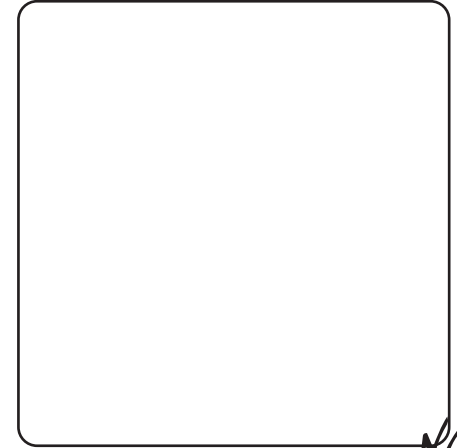
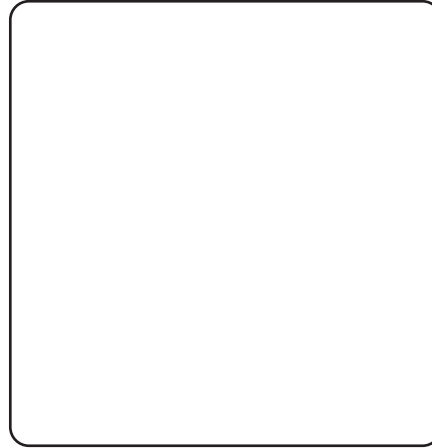

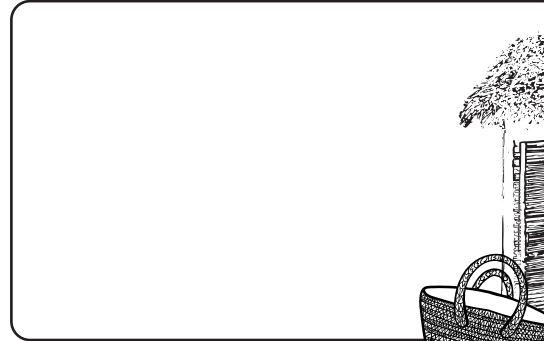
The Cayman Islands National Museum, through its exciting programs, connects us to our past. The museum makes sure that everyone can explore the unique features and history of our beautiful islands.

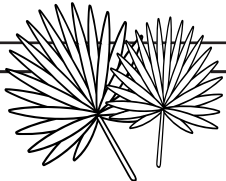


THE NATIONAL GALLERY OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

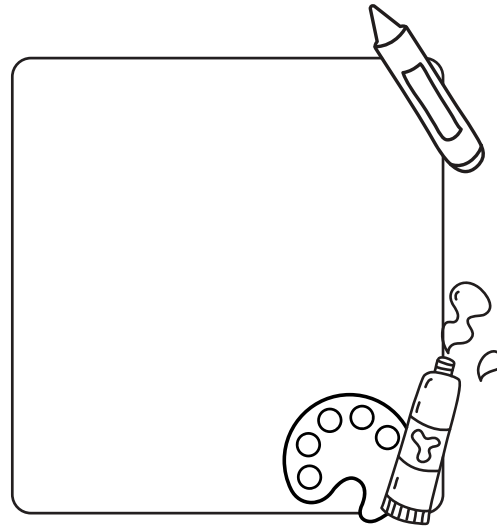
